Jang Hyun sung, the founding member of Hakchon, meets his teacher Kim Minghi at Hakchon, a place like his hometown.

Hakchon, a producer of high-quality children's and youths' plays that nurtured a number of actors, is a theater group and performance hall established in 1991 by the singer-song writer Kim Min ghi, who is known for songs like "The Morning Dew" and "Evergreen." This is where the Eagle five (Hwang Jeong min, Kim Yun seok, Seol Kyung gu, Jang Hyun sung, and Cho Seung woo) and many more actors first started their careers. Singer Kim Kwang seok performed here over 1,000 times, and there is a monument of him in front of the hall.



4. ARKO Arts Theater

ARKO Arts Theater is a major performing arts theater where over 100,000 performing artists and audience come together every year. The dream stage of all actors, ARKO Arts Theater is a major performing arts hall in Daehakro. Its red bricks, along with ARKO Art Center, are the symbols of Daehakro.



5. Ujd Promenade

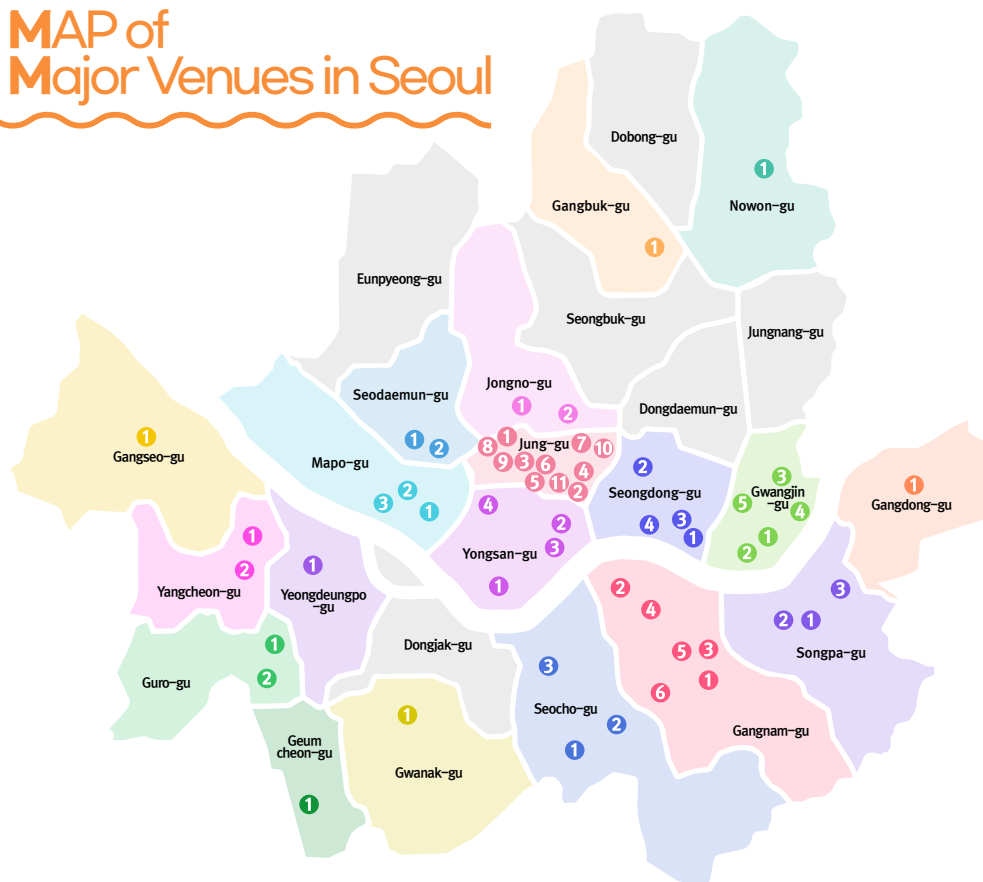
